3. Description of the main operation principles:
  - a. What fractions of textiles are collected?

  - c. What refining/sorting actions are done today? What is the sorting based on?
  - d. Where the textiles are sold/donated/addressed
  - e. Who are the customers?
  - f. Do you have any collaborative partners and what are the requirements on them?

4. Current volumes:

6. Future volumes:
  - a. What are the expected volumes of used textiles the organisation will be dealing with in 2-5 years?
  - b. Are there any noticeable trends?
  - c. Has there been a change in the volumes during the last years?
7. Future aspects:
  - a. Are there any specific barriers in today's textile flows, and how can these be handled?
  - b. How are you planning to develop your work in regards to handling used textiles?
8. Is there anything that the questions did not cover about your business that should be taken into consideration?
